Call 811 before you dig | Tennessee 811

Protect your community from the hazards of striking an underground utility line — always contact 811 before digging to avoid service disruptions caused by damaging buried utilities.



- STEP 1** **CALL 811** to request to have buried utilities marked.
- STEP 2** **PROVIDE INFORMATION** about your digging project (i.e. location, county, and type of project).
- STEP 3** **WAIT A FEW DAYS** to allow utilities to respond to your request. Ensure that all utilities have responded to your request before breaking ground.
